Language Arts

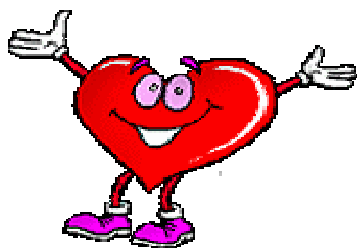

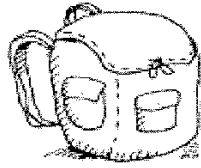
